Since 2014, Sisili Hanaro Encare Pvt. Ltd. has been at the forefront of addressing Sri Lanka's clinical waste crisis by leveraging advanced international technologies. In partnership with South Korean experts, we established Sri Lanka's first centralized clinical waste treatment facility through a Public-Private Partnership with the Central Environmental Authority and the Ministry of Health. This facility has become a model for managing hazardous waste, setting new standards for safe and efficient treatment.

As a certified leader in shipboard waste management, we handle hazardous and non-hazardous waste while adhering to stringent local and international regulations. Since 2022, our services have expanded to include Clinical Waste, Expired Pharmaceuticals, Quarantined Waste, and other non-hazardous materials, supported by certifications from the Marine Environmental Protection Authority, Sri Lanka Ports Authority, and Sri Lanka Customs.

In 2024, we further broadened our scope by introducing licensed e-waste management under Basel Convention guidelines, focusing on the safe export and recovery of valuable metals. Our Material Recovery Facility (MRF) plays a vital role in municipal waste management, processing diverse waste streams such as plastics from industrial and municipal sources. 


